

Claudia Sommer is a Professor of Neurology at the University of Würzburg, Germany. She received training in psychiatry, neuropathology, experimental anesthesia, and neurology. At the University of Würzburg, she serves as a consultant in neurology, organizes an outpatient clinic for patients with pain, and leads the Peripheral Nerve Laboratory. Research interests are the role of inflammation in the pathophysiology of pain, improvement and standardization of diagnostic biopsies, and the pathophysiology of antibody-mediated diseases. She has written more than 250 original research papers and more than 100 reviews and book-chapters and edited several books. Dr. Sommer is active in the development of national and international guidelines on the fibromyalgia syndrome, on nerve and skin biopsies, diagnosis and treatment of peripheral neuropathies, neuropathic and facial pain. She is a reviewer for scientific journals, the German Research Foundation (DFG) and serves on the editorial boards of several scientific journals. From September 2020, she will serve as president of the International Association for the Study of Pain (IASP).
